

School Uniform Policy

School uniforms are one of the ways we help children develop self-confidence. By wearing and taking care of their school uniform, children can learn to feel secure and confident in themselves. Our uniform policy reflects our values and reinforces our school's culture of high expectations. All pupils must dress according to the uniform policy. It is one way in which we identify ourselves as a school and it promotes a strong, cohesive identity which supports high standards in all areas of school life. It promotes harmony between different groups represented in the school.

The Head of School and Board of Directors decide the policy for school uniform which is reviewed periodically and request that the policy is adhered to by all families in a consistent way. We ask parents and carers to support all decisions by school staff regarding whether or not clothing is appropriate or inappropriate for school.

On accepting a place at CIS, parents agree to adhere to this policy, provide appropriate school uniform and footwear, and make sure the child wears the uniform.

Equal Opportunities

All children have equal access to wearing the CIS uniform items regardless of their gender, culture, race, religion, disability or ability. CIS is committed to creating a positive climate that will enable everyone to achieve their full potential. A smart, shared, practical school uniform is part of this commitment.

Required Uniform Items for Each Season

*School Skirt is optional. Those who have purchased school short pants may also purchase skirts. All pupils must purchase short pants, as they are worn in PE lessons and school events. In addition, the all-year-round shorts in size 120 will be on sale as soon as the stock of size L of the warm-weather/cool-weather shorts runs out.

*In cooler weather, children may wear tights or leggings underneath their shorts to keep them warm. These must be plain and black, white or beige coloured.

Outdoor clothing

Pupils should bring a coat to school each day during the cooler months. When travelling to and from school, the uniform must be worn correctly and in accordance with the school uniform policy. Uniform items should be clean and undamaged. Uniform items must not be replaced with home clothes unless absolutely necessary.

Footwear

Outdoor shoes must be closed-toed, hard-soled footwear with a flat sole. Open-toed sandals should not be worn, even in the Summer Term. Indoor shoes should be light, plimsoll style soft soled footwear. In the case of extreme weather children can wear boots to school but must change into a pair of indoor shoes on arrival to school.

Naming Clothing and Property

All clothing and property must be clearly named so that lost articles may be easily traced and returned. The school cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage of pupils' unnamed property and valuables. In some cases, the school may label the uniform to avoid loss of items.

Lost Property

We endeavour to return all named property.

Others

- > If girls use hair ribbons or pins, they should avoid flashy ones and use colours that match the colour of the uniform.
- Make-up is prohibited as well as manicures and pedicures. Large piercings / ornaments that might get stuck on clothes or injure other pupils may not be worn.
- > Do not sew patches onto the uniform or make any other alterations which distract from the original design.

Non-compliance with the Uniform Policy

It is the responsibility of all parents and staff to ensure that the school uniform policy is adhered to. There may be good reasons why a pupil is not wearing the school uniform. In this case, parents should share the reasons with the class teacher. Any request to deviate from the school uniform policy for reasons relating to disability, gender or religion must be agreed with the Head of School in advance. The school will always be considerate and discrete in trying to establish why a pupil is not wearing the correct uniform. Pupils will never be made to feel uncomfortable.

Parents and carers of pupils that do not wear the correct uniform will be contacted and asked to bring the correct uniform into school.

There will be occasions when the school decides that school uniform is not appropriate e.g. when taking part in a physical activity day, wearing different clothes as a part of a performance, fundraising or outdoor education events. Parents and carers will be notified in advance of the revised dress code on such days.

^{**}Pupils enrolling in May or October can wear either the warm or cool season uniform, as these months are considered transition periods. For further information, please refer to the *Parent Handbook*.

Appendix B - Guide for labelling names on uniforms and belongings

All clothing and property must be clearly named so that lost articles may be easily traced and returned. The school cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage of pupils' unnamed property and valuables. All names must be written in English using an oil-based pen.

Polo shirts: Label your child's name on either a yellow tag on the collar.



Pullover, Cardigans, Vests: Label your child's name on either a yellow tag on the collar.





School Shorts:

For the warm-weather shorts/cool-weather shorts, the names should be labelled on the yellow tag on the back waist.



For the all-year round shorts, label your child's name on the name tag that is stitched to the inside left seam of the shorts.



Skirts: Label your child's name on the name tag that is stitched to the inside left seam of the skirt.




Yellow T-Shirts: Label your child's name on either a yellow or white tag on the collar (the tag colour is different depending on the version purchased).




PE Cap, Straw Hats:

Label your child's name on the name tag located on the inner back side of the cap, or inside the rim of the hat.



Socks: Label your child's name on the inside of the elastic of the socks.



School Bag: Insert a label with your child's name inside the name tag holder on the back of the bag.



Indoor Shoes: Label your child's name on the front and back side of the shoes, written in a way that the teacher can read it as the example below.
